Advantages of Sugaring vs Waxing

Sugaring Paste	Wax
100% natural: pure sugar, citric acid, water. Since sugar is used to preserve food, it requires no additives, chemicals or preservatives. No harmful side effects.	Many chemical ingredients, mostly resins and preservatives. Can cause allergic reactions.
Natural healer to skin. Citric acid + sugar have healing properties. Will not damage delicate facial skin tissue from long term use.	Damages fine tissue cells. May damage facial skin tissue with long term use.
Sugaring paste nourishes your skin and also works like a defoliant as it removes impurities and dry skin cells during the sugaring. Your skin will be left smooth and comfortable.	Wax is irritating even if not damaging due to the ingredients, heat and direction of removal.
Hygienic and long lasting. Bacteria does not breed or survive in sugar.	Bacteria can breed in wax.
Will never burn skin as sugaring paste is ready to use at body temperature.	Wax has to be hot; it can burn and scar the skin. In long term use it is also associated with wrinkles especially in the lip and brow area.
Sugaring paste wraps around the hair shaft making it pliable. It reaches deep inside the follicles and gently encourages the extraction.	Since wax hardens on the hair, it has the tendency to break it off at the surface, rather than pull it out.
Sugaring paste is applied AGAINST the direction of hair growth and because of its soft consistency can sink in deeply to the hair follicle. It can reach much deeper down. The hair removal works WITH the natural direction of growth and doesn't break off the hair.	In general wax and other hair removal products are applied onto the skin WITH the direction of hair growth and therefore will only sink in superficially into the hair follicles, if at all. The epilation works AGAINST the direction of natural hair growth, so hairs break easily and grows back sooner.
Much less hair breaks!	The hair breaks!
